Linköping is Sweden's fifth largest city. The city has strong traditions as a regimental and county town. It's history as a modern industrial city began in 1937 when aircraft manufacturing was located to Linköping.

Linköping municipality, The County Council, Linköping University and companies such as Saab and Ericsson are examples of large employers in the city. Linköping University is one of Sweden's largest universities, with 40,400 student and 4,500 employees. In close collaboration with the business world and society, Linköping University (LiU) conducts world-leading, boundary-crossing research in fields including materials science, IT and hearingment.

Located near the university is Linköping Science Park, an attractive home to 600 innovative companies employing more than 7,000 people. Linköping Science Park offers a broad base of support and activities to encourage and stimulate growth and success among its companies — from start-ups to multi-nationals.

As the first Swedish city Linköping won the European Capital of Innovation Awards 2023, in the category European Rising Innovative City! By innovation and collaboration, we are creating the life-friendly city of the future.

The university hospital and Linköping University has a well established cooperation in medical research and education. The hospital has gone through renovation to create a hospital for the future where medical care, research and education meet in modern environments.

One of the main attractions in Linköping is the cathedral. Besides being beautiful, the cathedral is interesting in its architecture and is extremely well preserved. In April 2023, Linköping's new swimming hall - Tinnerbäcksbadet, which is Sweden's most modern swimming hall - was inaugurated. The city's main event venues include Saab Arena, Linköping Konsert & Kongress and Bilbörsen Arena.
